A failing septic system is an illicit discharge and a violation of Lexington County Stormwater Ordinance and a public health risk. By applying to this replacement program, there is no guarantee that the request will be funded.

All documents shall be submitted as one package for Septic Tank Repair and Replacement assistance, please use and submit the following checklist:

1. Application Form completed and signed.

2. Current year property tax paid receipt.

3. Proof of residency (i.e. electricity or water bill).

4. Three (3) written quotes from SCDES licensed septic contractors. Quotes shall be like for like as to represent the same solution/fix for the sewage disposal system. Quote shall include fine grading with positive drainage and permanent stabilization with warm season grass seed appropriate for the site. Seed shall be applied and raked according to best practices. Straw shall be spread to hold the seed in place. Alternative methods of stabilization may be considered on a case by case basis.
